QUEST 267


The new 26 foot Quest is the first of a series in this size. The Quest is designed around family sport fishing and pleasure boating. It has comfortable sleeping berths to accommodate four adults, a galley with sink, two burner stove and an ice box standard. The large galley counter top folds to the cabin bulkhead for easy entry into the aft berths. The portable head is standard with a pumpout as an option. The Quest has a walk around deck, with an anchor locker and bow pulpit. The deck and cockpit floor are non-skid fiberglass and self draining, making clean up easy. The 267 Quest is available with MerCruiser's revolutionary extended driveshaft, or with conventional stern drive power. The extended shaft eliminates the inconvenience of the stern motorbox and allows for completely flush floors. A boat of this caliber would not be complete without plenty of storage. The Quest has fish wells with overboard drains, bait wells, ice chest, plenty of dry storage and rod storage. The best fishing spot on the water is in a 267 Quest from 4 Winns.





SUNDOWNER 225

The second largest of the 4 Winn's fleet simply is in a class by itself. It planes easily with large loads without the aid of trim tabs and can do it with small engines. It rides well and boasts the smoothest ride available. The deep cockpit will keep you dry and safe. A galley can be an added option. (shown on page 26).



SEAJAUNT

A whole new concept in stern drive propulsion is available through 4 Winns and MerCruiser with this model. The engine is placed mid-ship connecting the stern drive with a drive shaft and frees the stern area for hauling in the big ones, as well as adding 29 inches of free-board for added safety. The walk-around cuddy allows fishing 360° and yet has a spacious cabin. With an optional portable head, it is a perfect family fishing craft. It's 20'4" hull is easily trailered, yet large enough to handle big water. It's big flared bow fends off the rollers and the mid engine balances the craft, allowing it to plane at slower speeds. All the advantages of an inboard, but with the convenience, control and shallow water capabilities of an I.O. This boat is designed and intended for the serious fisherman. If you fit into this class, this boat is for you.





Ordinary, chopped glass hulls don't have the ability to distribute stress over a large area as do continuous strands of woven roving. The chopped glass fractures (because it can't flex like woven roving). Moreover, our hand-lay-up design gives you a lighter hull. It's easier for a smaller car to tow on the road. Less energy is required to push the boat. So you save three ways; lower initial cost, less fuel consumption and long hull life.


Also in all 4 Winns boats there is wood reinforcing under the fittings to prevent them from pulling out. The wood floor and stringers are completely encased in fiberglass for strength and permanence. Rigid cell, urethane foam fills all spaces between stringers and floors fusing the hull bottom and sides to the stringers and flooring. This, combined with the hand-layed woven roving and mat hulls, gives you a 4 Winns boat built to last and last and last.
